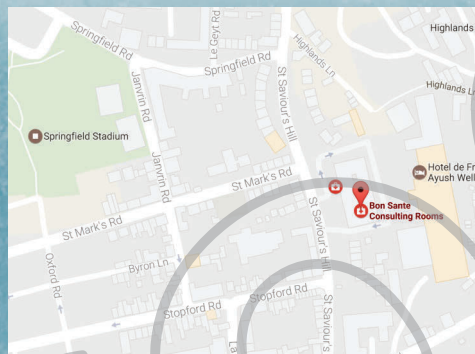

Invoices and fees

Charges

Charges are inclusive of hospital equipment and professional reporting fees. Please be aware that each test will result in separate invoices from the hospital and from Dr Mitchell. Late (within 24 hours) cancellation may result in a cancellation charge.

Payment is expected within 30 days. Interest at 2% above base rate will be charged after 60 days. Late payments will be referred to a collection agency.

Private insurance

If you have private medical insurance then it is important to check your level of cover from your policy when you call for pre-authorisation. Some insurance companies may not cover the full costs of consultations, tests and procedures. You would therefore be responsible for any short-fall.
